NEW GUIDELINES for Recording Part-breds and Anglo Arabs – May 2013

No LATE PENALTIES for horses over 3 years of age!

DNA & Parentage Verifications ***compulsory*** with **Pure-Bred Arabs**.

DNA ***not compulsory*** with **Part-bred & Anglo Arabs**.

If your **Stallion** is the 350th to be registered, you will have all your levies for this year free!

If your **Mare** is the 700th to be registered, you will have all your levies for this year free!

If your **Gelding** is the 250th to be registered, you will have all your levies for this year free!

The following is required when **recording** a part-bred or Anglo Arab **mare or gelding**:

1. **Birth notification form**
2. **R 100**
3. *If the dam was not owned by the breeders, a **Lease Letter** from the owner is needed, stating that the breeder who leased the mare may register the foal under his prefix and name.*
4. *If the sire was not owned by the breeder, then a **Service Certificate** to accompany the Birth Notification.*

The following is required when **recording** a part-bred or Anglo Arab **stallion**:

1. **Birth notification form**
2. **R 100**
3. **Vet Certificate:** All Stallions need a Certificate from the Vet stating that they qualify as breeding Stallions (must have 2 healthy testes/ testicles)
4. **CEM Certificate:** All Stallions used to sire foals need to be tested for CEM.
